Highlights

- 371 international visitors were selected as emerging leaders by the U.S. State Department and hosted in New Hampshire by the Council for professional development;
- 259 individuals, businesses and non-profits donated time to exchange ideas with their international counterparts on topics ranging from good governance to freedom of the press;
- **20 families** opened their homes to a visitor to share a meal.
- 8 high school teams competed in the first annual Academic WorldQuest competition, testing their knowledge of international issues, and
 100 students took part in the Plymouth Model UN Conference.
 - Thousands of people around the state deepened their understanding of world affairs and discussed pressing global issues at more than 30 (mostly free) events in 2015, including lectures and films.
